

### **SPRING CE 2010**

Spring CE is scheduled for April 17, 2010 in Helena, Montana. This spring, we will focus on Medical Emergency Management as it relates to standards of care, assessing patient risk and potential emergencies, anesthetic-related emergencies plus office preparation for emergencies. Unique to this program, is the presentation of actual taped emergencies and patient interviews. You will feel as if you are experiencing the emergency (without having to be there). This will also be an interactive lecture using an audience response system.

Spring CE will be presented by Dr. David Canfield, who maintains a private practice of dental anesthesiology in Dallas-Fort Worth, Texas. He has provided office-based anesthesia services for 23 years. He is a professor and dental anesthesiologist for the Veteran's Administration Medical Center and the Department of Aging and Disability Services for the state of Texas. He is formerly the coordinator of pain and anxiety control at Baylor College where he was responsible for anesthesia and for emergency training of staff, students, residents and faculty. He has developed teaching curriculum and video programs related to sedation, general anesthesia and management of medical emergencies.
